É Assured and consistent access to ARVs and to services that link patients to care.

## Challenges

- É Understanding a new environment with new mechanisms for access to health care -- identifying the benefits and limitations to insurance plans.
- É Capacity for Educators to navigate the ACA environment amongst all their duties.



# How Are Patients, Communities, Educators being prepared: Top 3

#### 1. Health and Insurance Literacy

Developing a Blueprint to assist patients in enhancing their health and insurance literacy to better understand and navigate insurance and health marketplaces

#### 2. Mobilizing communities

Working with representatives of communities of color and minority populations to help educate and advocate around the ACA.

#### 3. Capacity Building for Educators and Community Organizations

To ensure that organizations that are the point of first contact are able to answer questions or direct their constituents to relevant information, websites or people.
