



- Up to 20 symptoms were collected
- Number of patients
- 2% of symptoms reported

Symptoms vs adherence

- Coughing or trouble catching my breath
- Problems with weight loss
- Fevers, chills or sweats
- Sad, down, or depressed
- Pain, numbness or tingling in my hands or feet



Side Effects (SE) vs Disease



- 4 studies collected the information
- 2 783 patients answered the question,
 - Do you think the symptom is caused by,
 - HIV disease
 - HIV Medication
 - Other answers

Summary of Top 5 Symptoms

Symptoms	Low Adherence	Caused by HIV	Side Effect
Fatigue	Cough	Depressed	Fatigue
Depressed	WT loss	Sleep	Diarrhea
Sleep	Fever	Anxiety	Nausea
Muscle ache	Depressed	Muscle ache	Pain
Diarrhea	Pain	Fatigue	Stomached



Discussion

- No objective determination
- All symptoms are self-reported by patients.
- Differentiate the cause by HIV or by medication

- Symptoms vs Adherence
 - ▶ Can not determine the "order"
 - ► No causal relationship in this study

20 Symptoms in MACH14 study

- 1. Fatigue or loss of energy
- 2. Fevers, chills or sweats
- 3. Dizzy or lightheaded
- 4. Pain, numbness or tingling in my hands or feet
- 5. Memory/Trouble remembering
- 6. Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea or loose bowel movements
- 8. Sad, down, or depressed
- 9. Nervous or anxious
- 10. Difficult falling or staying asleep

- 11. Skin problems (rash, dryness or itching)
- 12. Coughing or trouble catching my breath
- 13. Headaches
- 14. Loss of appetite or a change in the taste of food
- 15. Bloating, pain or gas in my stomach
- 16. Muscle aches or joint pain
- 17. Problems of having sex
- 18. Changes in the way my body looks
- 19. Problems with weight loss
- 20. Hair loss or change in the way of my hair looks
