

Reduced exercise, physical activity, or sleep	30% (21)
Avoided social support	23% (16)

Withdrew from faith-based or spiritual support	20% (14)
Missed doses of medication	17% (12)
Income loss	11% (8)
Avoided health care	11% (8)
Missed days of school or work	9% (6)



Transgender Women




Non-Transgender Women


