 - Public/private partnerships
 - Build on existing platforms

 Mobile apps for health, with few exceptions, are not widely downloaded

- Solutions
 - Integration with popular apps
 - Bundling successful components to get scale for marketing

The Cycle Problem

 The cycle from idea, funding, testing and deployment is too long

- Solutions
 - Build on existing platforms
 - Build infrastructure to test specific active agents
 - Develop an enterprise with higher levels of ownership





The Ownership Problem

 Health Departments/CDC have resources do scale but limited tech CBA capacity 0

- Solutions
 - Use existing CBA mechanisms with Tech focus
 - Test cases to build capacity in HDs
 - Consideration of effective intervention criteria
 - IS studies
