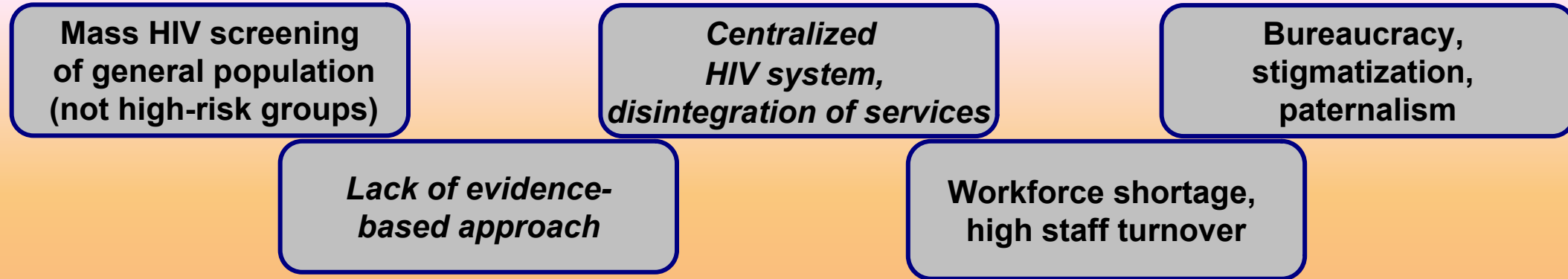

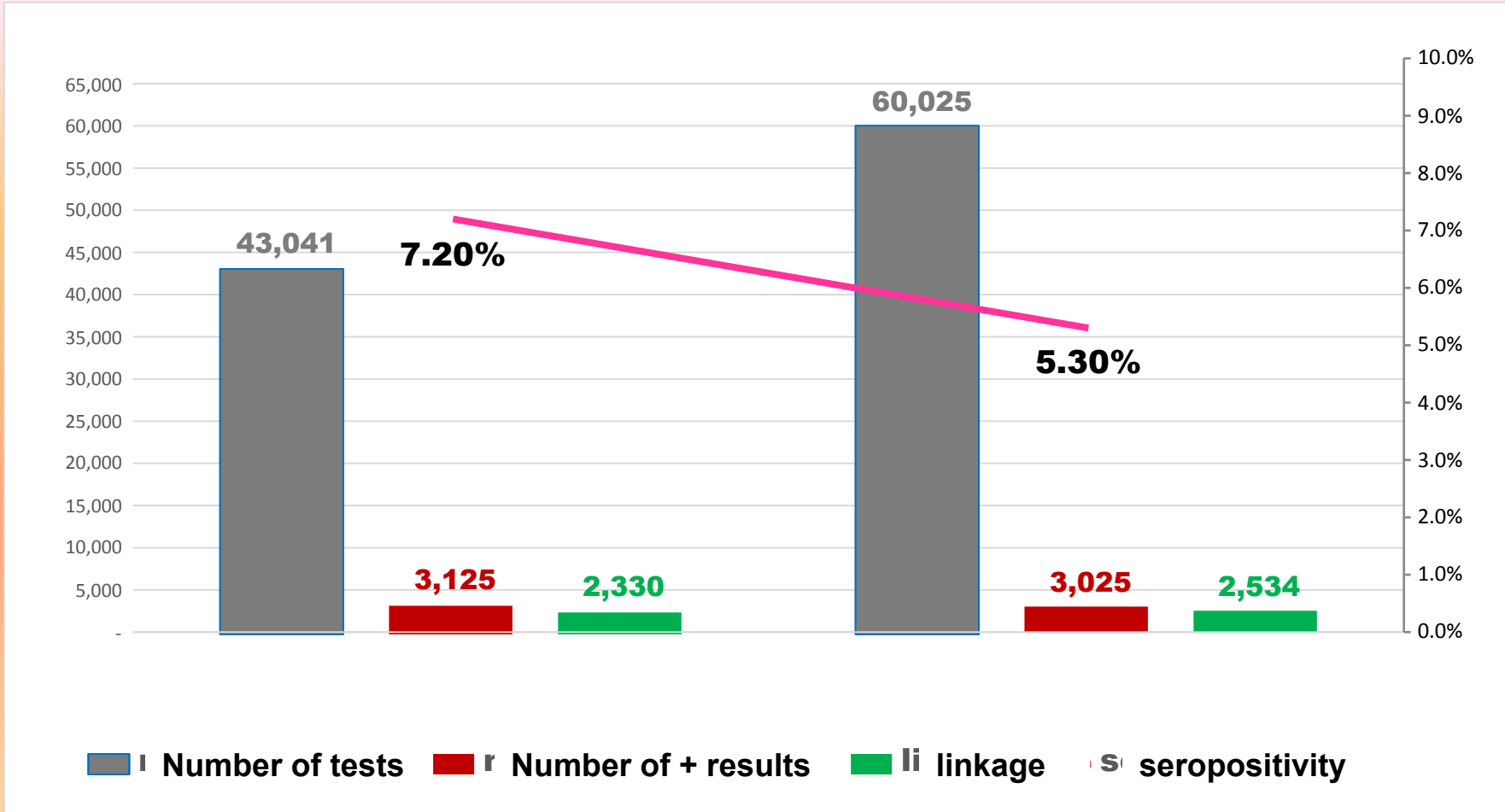
Challenges to AIDS Control in the Region



AHF Europe Care Model As a Response to Challenges

1. Targeted to high-risk groups outreach rapid testing with linkage
2. *Decentralized ART, integrated care (HIV, TB) in one location close to client*
3. Simplified procedures, staff education on service provision and client-orientation
4. *Regular data collection and quality review*
5. Task-shifting, payment to staff based on performance

2014: 681

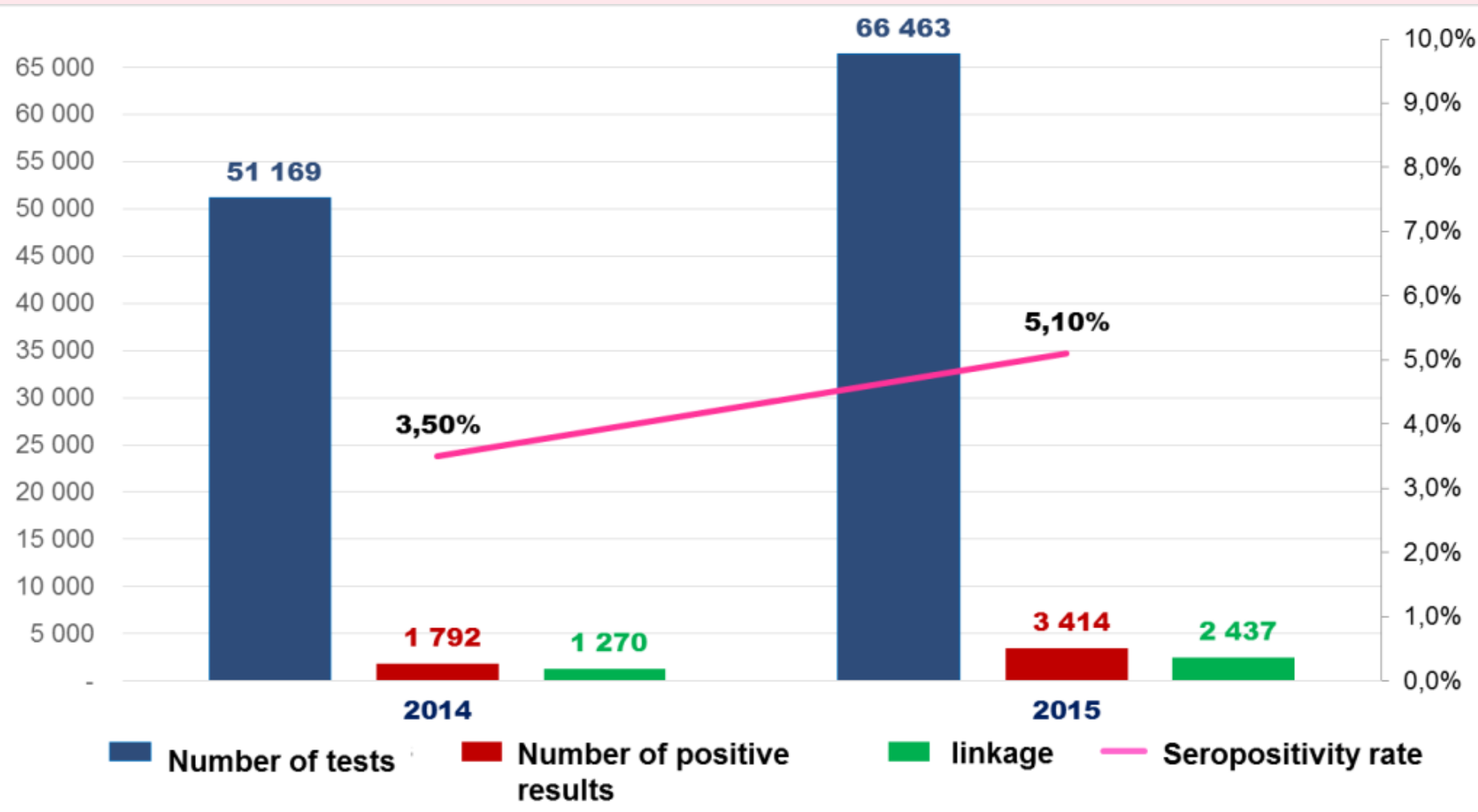
(22% out of all results)

(82% out of all results)

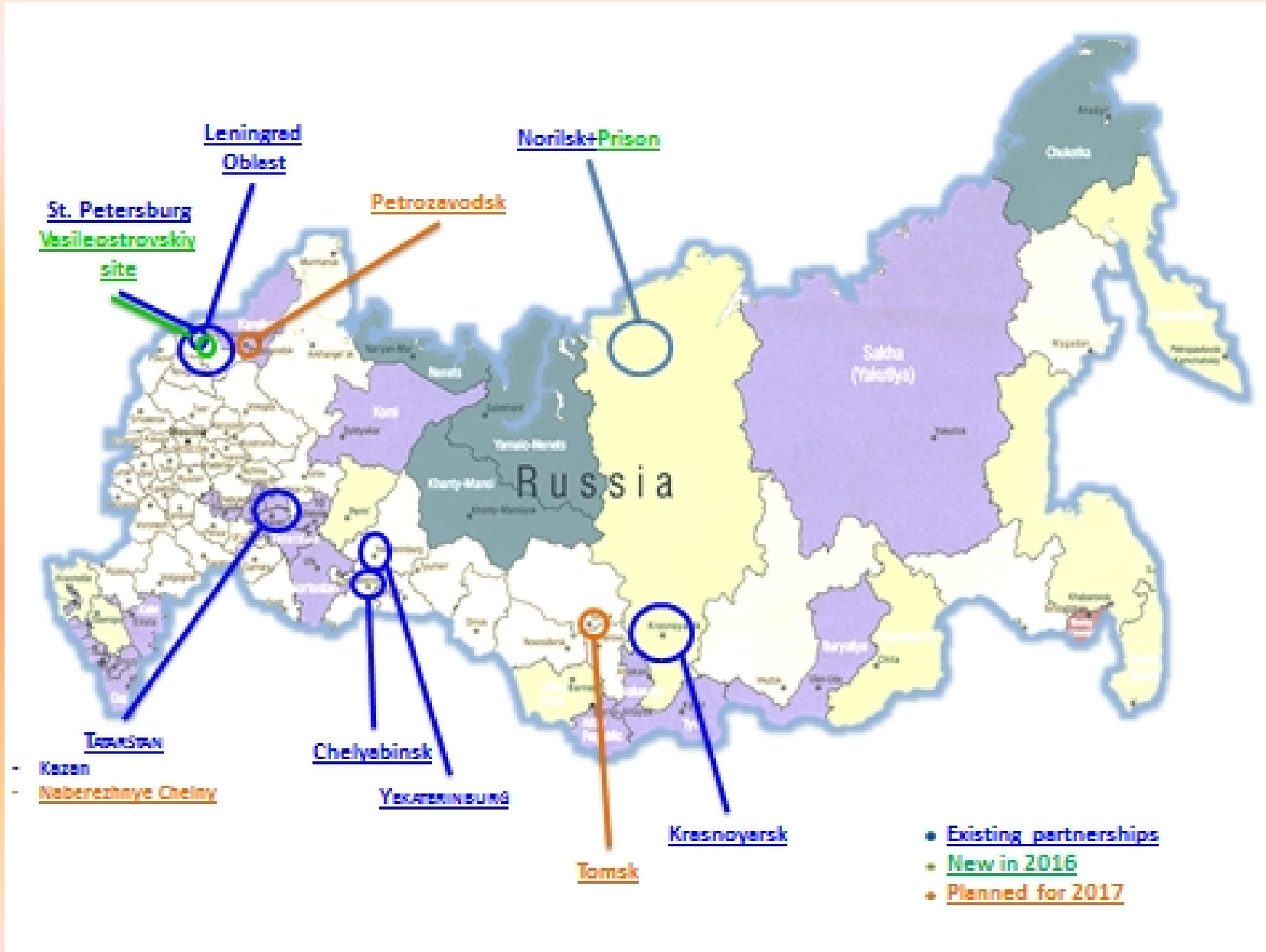

AHF Clinical Programs in Russia

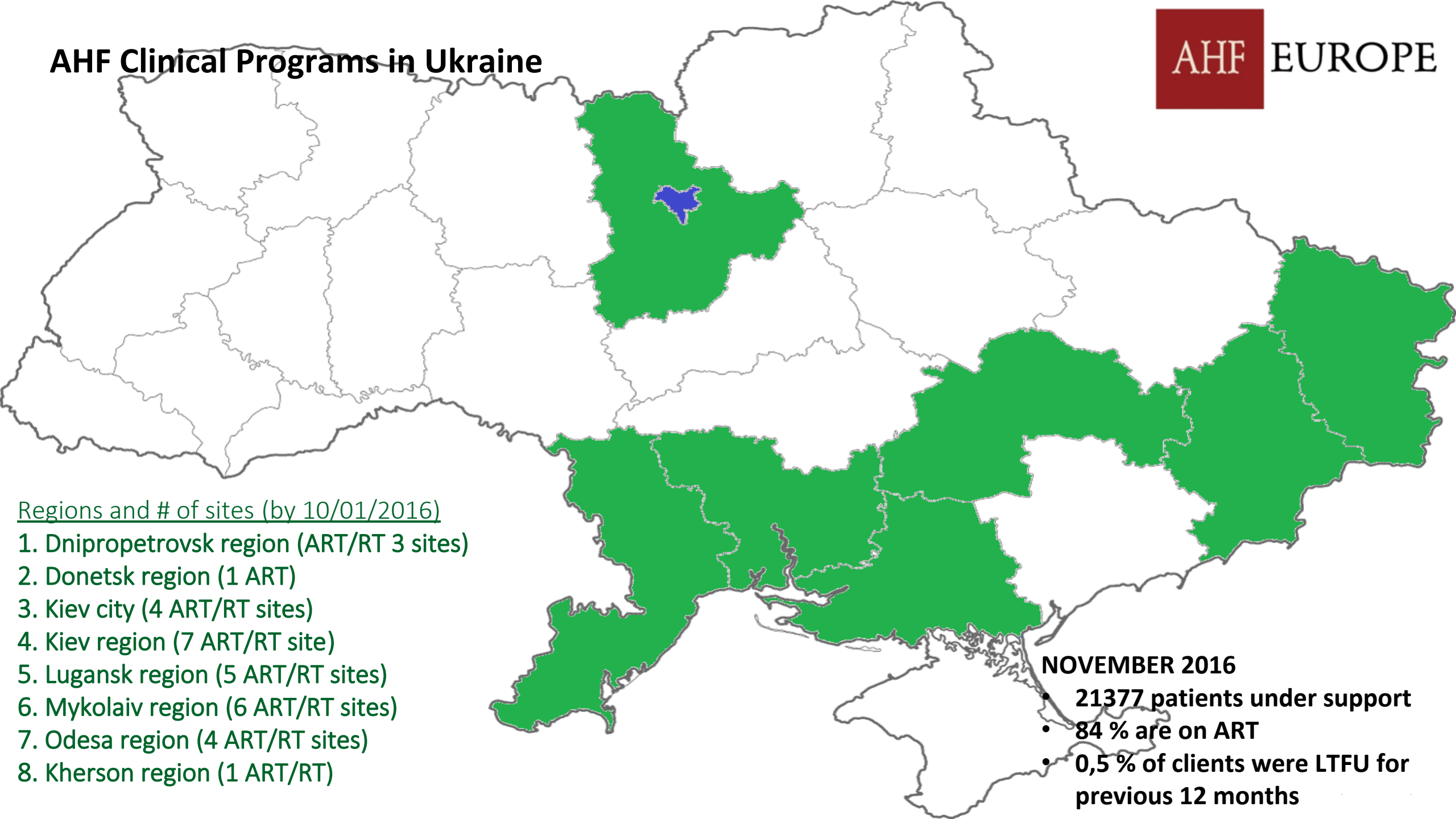


NOVEMBER 2016
