Dear Colleagues,

Welcome to the 2019 90-90-90 Targets Update in Mexico Clty.

The International Association of Providers of AIDS Care (IAPAC) is proud to host this IAS 2019 satellite symposium in collaboration with the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS) and the Global Network of People living with HIV (GNP+).

Our aim during this year's 90-90-90 Targets Update is to highlight successes achieved and challenges faced globally, nationally, and locally as communities affected by HIV worldwide strive to attain and surpass the 90-90-90 targets. We do so with the clear understanding that 90-90-90 is a starting point on a trajectory towards getting to zero new HIV infections and zero AIDS-related deaths.

The UNAIDS "Communities at the Centre" report released last week in South Africa delivered good news that some countries are making impressive gains, notably in eastern and southern Africa. So, too, are many cities and municipalities accelerating their local HIV responses as part of the Fast-Track Cities initiative. But the report also notes that these gains are not universal, and that key populations and their sexual partners now account for 54% of new HIV infections globally.

Thank you to our distinguished faculty as they provide global perspectives about 90-90-90 and HIV epidemic control, and report at country, municipal, and city levels about their progress to date and the barriers they are addressing to attain the programmatic targets by 2020 (or 2025). Among these barriers is persistent stigma against people living with and affected by HIV – a public health crisis we can only address through a human rights- and equity-based approach to ending AIDS as a public health threat by 2030.
