2013-2016: Transparency & accountability (7.7 mil Tx)

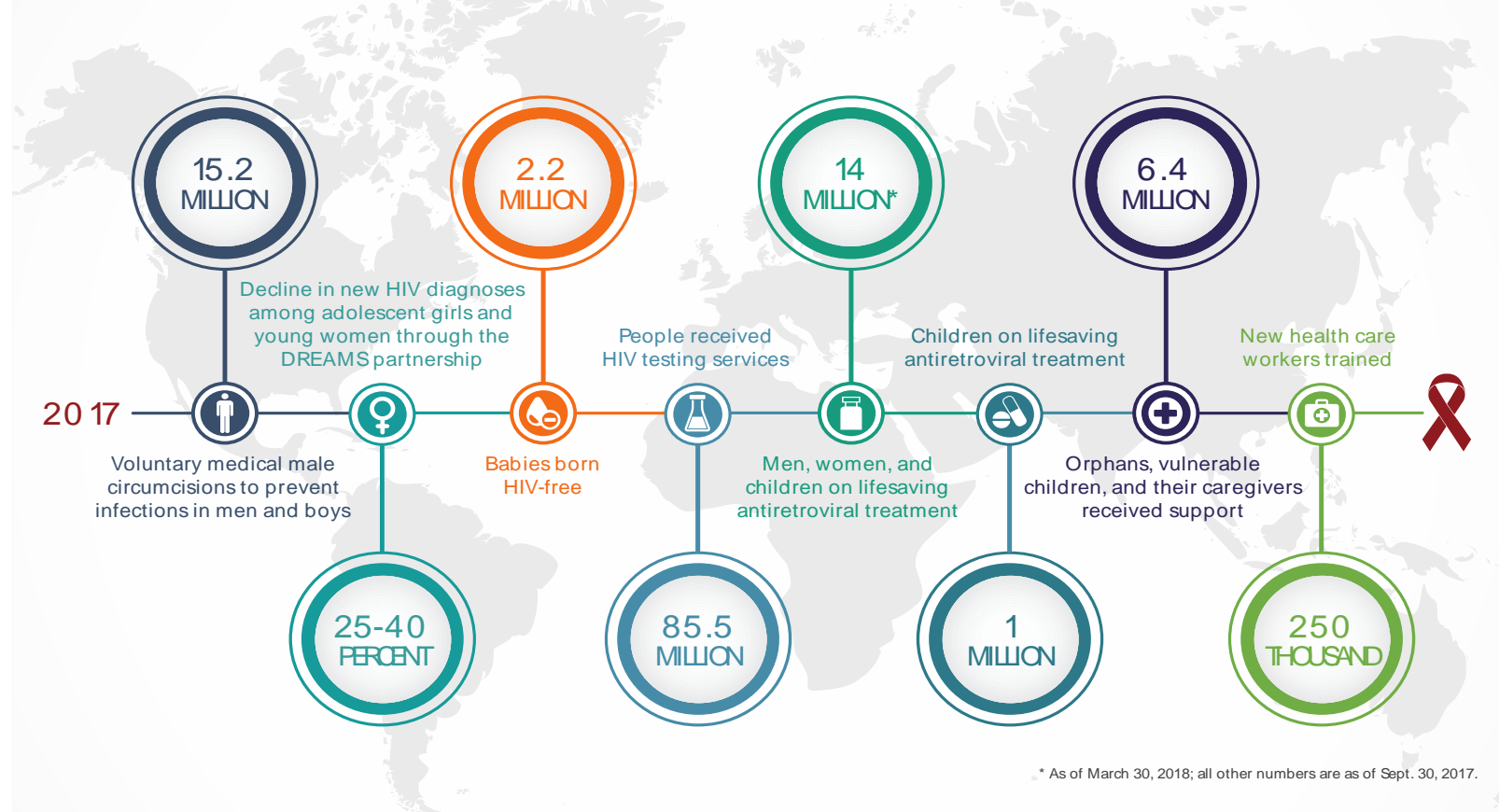

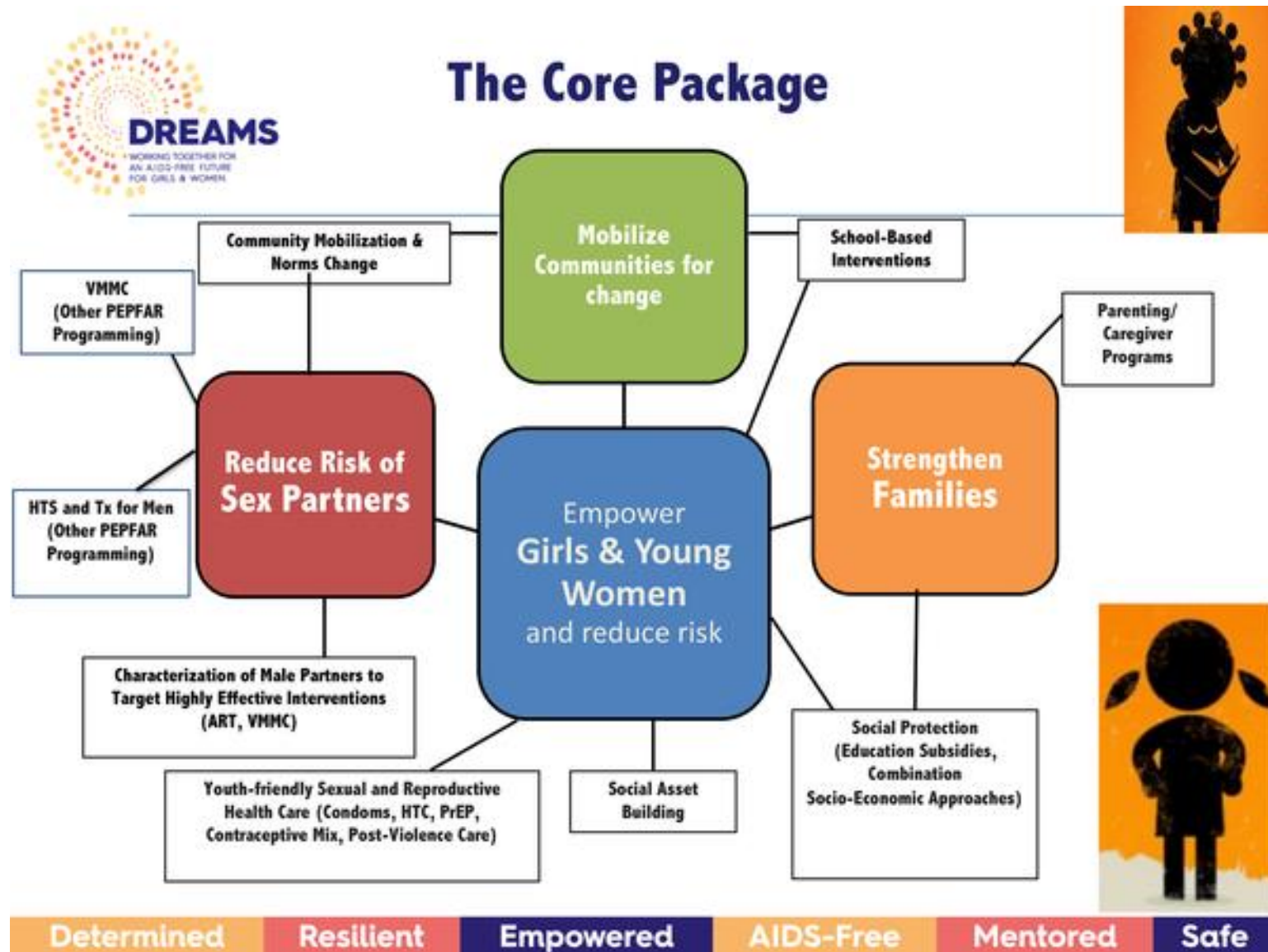
