ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Fast-Track Cities 2022 will be the fourth international conference convening more than 400 cities that are accelerating their responses to HIV, tuberculosis, and viral hepatitis. The conference will take place in a hybrid format both virtually and in-person at the Barceló Sevilla Renacimiento.

Fast-Track Cities 2022 is organized by the International Association of Providers of AIDS Care (IAPAC), in collaboration with the Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS), Fast-Track Cities Institute, Stop TB Partnership, and World Hepatitis Alliance.

WHO ATTENDS

Delegates will include elected officials, public health department representatives, clinical/public health researchers, healthcare payors, donors/grantors, clinicians, service providers, and civil society advocates from current and prospective Fast- Track Cities.

WORKSHOP PROGRAMMING

The conference's aim is to highlight successes achieved across the Fast-Track Cities network, address cross-cutting challenges faced by local stakeholders, and share best practices in accelerating urban HIV, TB, HBV, and HCV responses. Building upon the successes of the past three global gatherings of the Fast-Track Cities network, this year's conference will provide space for interactive dialogue to support a network of "connected cities," facilitating the collaborative development of innovative approaches to attaining the goals, objectives, and targets to which all Fast-Track Cities are committed. The conference program will comprise a combination of plenary sessions, panel discussions, city/municipal case studies, oral and e-poster sessions, and skills-building workshops.



Cities play a critical role in the HIV epidemic's response. More than half of the world's population currently live in cities, and in most countries, cities account for a large and growing proportion of the national HIV burden.

City dynamics and networks can also contribute to an increased risk of HIV transmission in cities. On the other hand, cities offer advantages and important opportunities for programming, effective action and innovations to end AIDS.

Fast-Track Cities is a global partnership between cities and municipalities around the world.

Eight years since the launch of the Fast-Track Cities network, more than 400 cities and municipalities have signed the *Paris Declaration on Fast-Track Cities*, committing to accelerate their local responses to attain HIV and TB programmatic targets, as well as zero stigma. Since July 2018, Fast-Track Cities are also working towards HBV and HCV elimination.

Advanced collaboratively with local stakeholders, intervention areas include data generation/ monitoring, implementation planning, capacity-building, community engagement, stigma elimination, and quality of care and life assessments.
