




European Countries








Life Expectancy (birth) 2013 & 18



Population satisfied with the availability of quality health care in the area where they live, 2020 (or nearest year)










Figure 1.5: Percentage of new HIV diagnoses with known mode of transmission, by transmission route and countries EU/EEA, 2020 (n=10949)




COHORT OF CHAMPIONS: TIMELINE

Measuring Success

- Evidence of progress across the cascade of care and/or towards 95:95:95 in at least 5 members
- At least six partnership agreements signed, and other twinning processes to be documented
- Evidence of action within partnerships regular touchpoints between all participating FTCs
- Dissemination of key outcomes to affected communities in participating FTCs
- Final report including recommendations disseminated across all European Fast-Track Cities.

The Champions Challenge

- Discrepancies in health indicators across Europe;
- Different healthcare systems with different governing-body structures
- Heterogenous healthcare delivery mechanisms: facilities and workforce
- Legal constraints
- Different HIV epidemics and trends
- Single Fast Track cities working alone in some countries.



The Champions Potential Impact

- Improved outcomes for people living with and at risk of HIV
- Making progress towards 95:95:95
- Greater resilience across the Fast Track Network
- Sharing best practice
