

The city of Dnipro joined the global partnership "Fast-Track Cities » in October 2020. At the time of signing the declaration, our city was included in the anti-ratings of Ukraine regarding the prevalence of HIV infection per 100,000 population, the prevalence of HIV among pregnant women in Ukraine, and the transmission of HIV from mother to child.

Therefore, one of the key areas of combating HIV was decided to focus on the prevention of mother-to-child transmission of HIV through the efforts of social protection systems, health care, and support from civil society.

THE FULL-SCALE RUSSIAN INVASION INTO UKRAINE PRESENTED THE CITY WITH MANY CHALLENGES:

Internally displaced women and women living with HIV need housing, basic humanitarian assistance, legal support, psychosocial and medical assistance, and this is not full list of their needs.



Stigma and discrimination against people living with HIV remains a deterrent to seeking medical care, especially for internally displaced women.

Dnipro city council Healthcare department, together with the department of social protection and CO «CS «100% LIFE DNIPRO» held an information session campaign to overcome stigma and provided chain continuous services to support HIV positive people women , mothers and theirs children.

Also, for the protection of women and women with children in the city of Dnipro, the Communal Institution of Social **Protection "Center for Social Support of Children and Families** "Mother's Happiness" of the Dnipro City Council operates in Dnipron city. Pregnant women in the last trimester of pregnancy, single mothers with children who have found themselves in difficult life circumstances, women with children and women without children who have suffered from domestic violence can receive services at the institution, in particular women and women with children from among internally displaced persons (hereinafter - IDPs). Since the beginning of Russia's war with Ukraine, 237 women with 123 children have received social services at the Center , including 26 women with **47** children from among IDPs.

In order to provide the residents of the city of Dnipro with a decent standard of living by providing additional local social guarantees in the form of events and providing social services to vulnerable groups of the population who have socially dangerous diseases, in July 2023, changes were made to the Comprehensive Program of Social Protection of the Residents of the City of Dnipro for 2022 -2026, approved by the decision of the city council dated 06/23/2021 No. 19/8.


On the initiative of CO «CS «100% LIFE DNIPRO», the section of Social support for families, children and youth who belong to vulnerable population groups and/or are in difficult life circumstances of the Comprehensive program of social protection of the residents of the city of Dnipro, as part of the project "Fast-Track Dnipro" (Fast-Track Dnipro), supplemented by social services for vulnerable population groups with socially dangerous diseases.

Thus, for 2023-2026:

 for the purchase of social services regarding social support for HIV-infected pregnant women and women giving birth ; families raising HIV-infected children;
 UAH 340 000 is provided for families in which HIVinfected persons live

 for the purchase of a social service related to the social adaptation of persons released from serving a sentence for crimes related to the use, storage or distribution of narcotic substances; UAH 480 000 is provided for social support of HIV-infected persons or persons with sexually transmitted infections (STIs) - UAH 380 000 is provided for the purchase of social services for social and psychological rehabilitation of persons addicted to narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances

The implementation of measures within the framework of the "Fast-Track Dnipro" project will ensure that persons belonging to vulnerable population groups, among the city's residents, receive various types of social services and create an accessible environment that will contribute to the growth of the level and quality of life these layers of the population, improving the social situation in the city of Dnipro



 Purchased for city budget: 500 HIV studies;

- 11 104 studies for viral hepatitis; others - at the expense of the National Health Service, NGOs, and the state budget.





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


women of childbearing age received hormonal contraceptives for money of city budget For the period from 2020 to 2023, the number of women who were detected for the first time during pregnancy decreases :









Observation in progress of pregnancy of women with HIV is organized according to the multidisciplinary principle. In the conditions of city AIDS center, HIV-infected pregnant women receive medications for the treatment of sexually transmitted infections and genital infections from the city budget (in 2022- 273 women, in 2023 -311 women). HIV-pregnant women are provided with folic acid at the expense of the city budget .

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47 women, 36 of them are city residents, others residents areas who chose Dnipro city institutions for childbirth, recieved Cabergoline to terminate lactation (NGO). 99 % of children born in 2022 were on artificial feeding .
18 children received baby formulas from the city budget, others received mixtures as humanitarian aid

1 woman refused from artificial feeding

33 children born from HIV+ mothers, received Trimethoprim / sulfamethoxazole at the expense of city budget .

HIV- infected and AIDS patients are provided with medicines for prevention and treatment of opportunistic infections at the expense of city budget

Main Organization projects are aimed at:

"Implementation of a package of care and support services for PMTCT (prevention of transmission of infection from mother to child) for pregnant women and mothers from key population groups who are in a humanitarian situation in the city Dnipro, Ukraine".

From 01.01.2023 to 08.30.2023

In total, **403** PLHIV women were covered by the project services , including:

PLWH pregnant women - **44** in total (**10** of which are representatives of Dnipro region);

PLWH IDPs - **107** in total (**9** of which are representatives of the region); PLWH women who found themselves in difficult life circumstances - **253** women.



The "Colposcope" device, was purchased and handed over for the city AIDS center.

Medication for suppression of lactation "Dostinex " was purchased and handed over for pregnant PLHIV patients of the city AIDS center.

Despite Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine, millions of refugees and IDPs, endless shelling and destruction of infrastructure, the city of Dnipro is able to implement an effective program to combat mother-to-child transmission of HIV.

In 2022 year Dnipro managed to provide HIV testing for 97% of pregnant women; 98% of pregnant women with HIV positive status were provided with HAART and there was provided 98% of preventive treatment for infants born to HIV- positive


In 2023 HIV testing was provided for 98% of pregnant women; HAART was provided for 100% of pregnant women with HIV positive status and 100% preventive treatment was provided for babies

born to HIV- positive mothers.
