We currently manage 10 ongoing projects and partnerships. With offices in The Hague, Netherlands, and Cape Town, South Africa, our work spans all continents, primarily Africa, Latin America, and Asia. Our network includes over 6,000 adolescents and young people.

About Youth Next Level

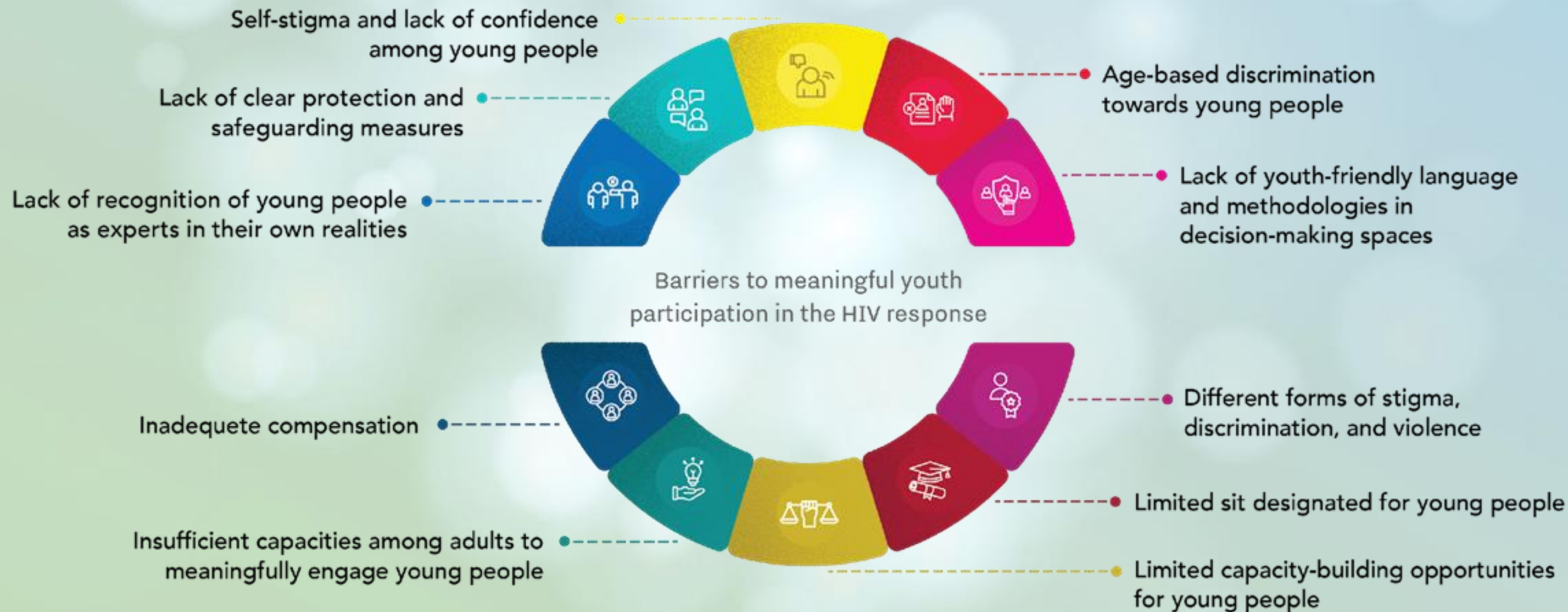
- Youth Next level Guidance is a tool developed to strengthen the roles of youth in national and local HIV responses.
- It is meant for governments, civil society, donors and UN country teams working in partnership with youth.
- It encourages meaningful involvement of young people not just as beneficiaries but as partners and leaders in shaping HIV interventions
- Youth Next Level Guidance was developed by UNAIDS and the Global Network of Young People Living with HIV (Y+ Global).

Youth Next Level is a suite of resources. Supporting resources were also developed, including a definitions guide and steps for country roll out to support the scale-up of youth-led HIV responses.
