2. Prevention Staff
3. Pre- Counseling
4. Administer Test
5. Post Counseling
6. Results/Re-test
7. Linkage to Care

# THE TREATMENT PROCESS



### HIV Diagnosis and the Road to Health Success

- Referral to the clinic
- Nurse schedules appointment
- Doctors appointment
- Rapid start prescribed medications
- Next appointment scheduled Other medical referrals (LABS)
- Prevention education (PrEP, safe sex practices discussed, condom distribution).
- Stigma reduction

#### Linkage to Care

- Immediate referral after diagnosis
- Connection to Medical Case Managers
- Warm hand-offs between prevention staff and medical case management staff


#### Medical Case Management

- Intake & eligibility assessment
- Individualized care plan
- Coordination of medical appointments
- Addressing barriers: housing, transportation, insurance and other needs

#### Adherence Support

- Education on medication (ART)
- Support groups & Peer Advocates
- Ongoing monitoring (labs, viral load checks)
- Encouraging long-term engagement in care
